Topics/Scope of Agreements with CCIO

- **A. Data verification agreements for eligibility and enrollment**
 1. Verification of income, citizenship, national presence, residency, incarceration
 2. Minimal essential coverage (MEC)
 3. Medicaid eligibility, Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) eligibility
 4. Exemptions (if applicable)
 5. Appeals of eligibility determinations
 6. Eligibility for special enrollment periods (SEP)
 7. Advance premium tax credits (APTC)/Cost sharing reductions (CSRs) service (if applicable)

- **B. Other agreements to provide information or data**
- 8. Navigator program operations
- 9. Enrollment in qualified health plans (QHPs)
- 10. Certification of QHPs
- 11. Oversight of QHPs
