Notice is hereby given that on May 2, 2024 the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and Morehead Restorative Care Center in Moorhead Minnesota a skilled nursing facility in the Medicare program will be terminated.

In addition, as authorized by the Minnesota state Medicaid agency, notice is given that the facility's agreement as a nursing facility in the Medicaid program will be terminated effective May 2, 2024.

The Medicare program will not make payment for skilled nursing facility services furnished to residents admitted to the facility on or after April 27, 2024. For residents admitted prior to that date, payment may continue to be made for up to 30 days of services after May 2, 2024, the date of termination.

In addition, Federal Financial Participation will not be available to the State for any Medicaid residents admitted to the facility on or after April 27, 2024. For Medicaid residents admitted prior to April 27, 2024, Federal Financial Participation may continue to be made to the State for up to

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30 days of covered services to qualified residents furnished on or after May 2, 2024, the date of termination.
